Revolutionary new logistic system for the food processing industry

NAWI AGF introduces their newest system at the Fruit Logistica 2008: D.R.O.P. - The Distribution Related Order Picking system. A revolutionary new system for the food processing industry. It enables the manufacturer to deliver directly at shop level.

At shop level

The new D.R.O.P. system sorts deliveries directly at shop level. It sorts small and large order deliveries in a high volume oriented process.

Three steps

After installing the D.R.O.P system the distribution process has been reduced to three steps:

1. Processing PVF
2. Sorting at shop level
3. Delivery at shop level

Profit and logistic performance

The D.R.O.P. system accelerates profit and logistic performance of the distribution.

Straight forward

The D.R.O.P. system is a straight forward system.

The system destocks the buffered process and PVF packed crates. The system labels, traces and tracks. The D.R.O.P. system stacks trolleys directly at shop level.

Automated

The D.R.O.P system:

- automates the order picking
- creates an economic mix between manual and automatic order picking
- sorts crates automatically by purchase order.
- loads the trolleys automatically
- ensures the PLU order of each loaded stack

- Gives the manufactures higher profit margins

 - o Reduces Handling Costs
 - o Route order truck loading
- Accelerates logistic performance
 - o Sorts
 - o Is suitable for small and large delivery series
